Adventure Games and	Snakes, tree branches, bull ants	4	Activity sites are inspected prior to activities.
Orienteering	Sunburn	5	• Students wear hats and sunscreen for sun protection. Thalgarrah has extra sunscreen if required.
	Storms, high winds, extreme heat/cold	3	Activities are suspended. Bureau of Meteorology warnings and reports checked prior to activities.
	Allergic reactions, asthma, diabetes	3	Medical conditions are indicated to staff prior to activities.
			Measures are taken to eliminate, avoid or minimise exposure to known allergens.
	Uneven ground surfaces	4	Students are instructed to watch where they are running and warned of uneven surface.
	Falling, collision	6	Rules are set to minimise risk.
Orienteering	Student becomes lost	4	Activity sites are inspected prior to activities.
			Maps and routes are planned to have natural boundaries such as fences, tracks and water courses.
			Students are instructed on reading maps and plotting courses before the activity.
			Adults are positioned at strategic points throughout the course.
Shelter Building	Cut from pocket knife provided	4	• Students are instructed on safe handling of pocket knife including locking the blade and cutting the cord.
			Knives are collected after the shelter building activity.
Fire-lighting and BBQ lunch	Burns	4	Students are supervised at the campfire area and instructed in safe working. Water is close at hand.
	Food poisoning	4	Food is kept refrigerated until required.
			Adults supervise cooking and ensure food is suitably cooked before eaten.
General Supervision	Separation from group	4	Groups are instructed by EEC staff.
	Environmental dangers – snake bite,	4	A student to teacher ratio of 15:1 is to be maintained throughout outdoor experiences.
	water (drowning)		Students do not leave the activity site unless accompanied by an adult.
