Walking in the bush	Snakes, tree branches, bull ants	4	Activity sites are inspected prior to activities.
	Sunburn	5	• Students wear hats and sunscreen for sun protection. Thalgarrah has extra sunscreen if required.
	Storms, high winds, extreme	3	Activities are suspended. Bureau of Meteorology warnings and reports checked prior to activities.
	heat/cold		Medical conditions are indicated to staff prior to activities.
	Allergic reactions, asthma, diabetes	4	Measures are taken to eliminate, avoid or minimise exposure to known allergens.
	Uneven ground surfaces	4	Students are instructed to watch where they are walking and warned of uneven surface.
	Falling, tripping	6	Rules are set to minimise risk.
Microscopes	Burn from light bulb	5	Students are advised of location of bulbs and warned about the heat transmitted.
