Bureau of Meteorology warnings and reports checked prior to activities.</li> <li>Medical conditions are indicated to staff prior to activities.</li> <li>Measures are taken to eliminate, avoid or minimise exposure to known allergens.</li> <li>Students are instructed to watch where they are walking/running and warned of uneven surface.</li> <li>Rules are set to minimise risk.</li> </ul>
